### **Planning application: 6 Yew Walk, Harrow on the Hill. Ref: P/5490/18**

The Harrow Hill Trust Planning Committee has considered the sparse information provided with this application.

No justification is given for the replacement of the windows, nor photographs. So we do not know why the windows could not be repaired, since they are not that old.

If they are beyond repair, then there should be a like for like replacement. It is very important that the size, proportions and detailing are exactly the same as other houses in the estate, which have the same windows.

Any replacement windows should be white painted timber and under no circumstances should UPVC be allowed on any window, front or back, as these are prominent elevations in the conservation area.

Please note that Harrow School are the freeholders and their approval will be required. The application form does not recognise this and therefore it looks like the incorrect certificate has been used.
