### **Planning application: 1 Orley Farm Rd. Ref: P/5522/18**

Dear Tendai Mutasa

The Harrow Hill Trust Planning Committee has considered this application. We note the reasons the appeal inspector refused the previous application on this site, earlier this year, included:

- this locally listed building being “considered noteworthy” and able to “be seen from and does contribute to the street scene” of the conservation area;
- the development would “constrain the appearance of the dwelling on the plot”; and
- it would lead to “diminishing [of the dwelling’s] character by the alteration obscuring the feature chimney stack and some of the feature cottage style windows in the street scene.”

While the new application reduces somewhat the width and height of the proposed extension, we consider nevertheless that the conclusions of the inspector still apply and that the application should be refused.
